Tsitsikamma Itinerary

Storms River is a tiny scattered hamlet with shady lanes situated just north of Plettenberg Bay and on the edge of the Tsitsikamma forest. This ancient indigenous forest is a world of giant trees, forest ferns, clear streams and brightly coloured birds.

Storms River is the starting point for many adventure activities. Probably the most rewarding is the Canopy Tour where you swing between platforms built high in the forest canopy.

Storms River Mouth is found in the breathtaking Tsitsikamma National Park. There is a short walk along the rocky shoreline to the wonderfully wobbly suspension bridge across the mouth of the river.

- **Activity 1: The Big Tree**

This one is really BIG! This giant Yellowwood Tree (Podocarpus Falcatus) is well over 500 years old. The walk there and back is along a well-constructed wooden boardwalk, and is 1km in total. There are also 2 other walks here - 2.6km and 4.2km.

- **Activity 2: Tsitiskamma Nature Reserve**

Where the booming breakers of the Indian Ocean relentlessly pound rocky shores, where temperate high forest and fynbos roll down to the sea in an unspoilt verdant carpet, where ancient rivers carve their paths to the ocean down rocky ravines. This, "the place of much water", is the Tsitsikamma National Park. The heartland of the park stretches some 5 km to sea, protecting a wonderland of inter-tidal life, reef and deep-sea fish.

Dolphins frolic in the breakers, surfing and playing for the sheer joy of life, and the gentle giant of the ocean, the southern right whale visits here, coming inshore to breed.

- **Activity 3: Monkeyland**

Visitors to Monkeyland are taken on a monkey safari in the indigenous forest by experienced game rangers. On these safaris you can expect to see many species of primates ranging from the Gibbons of Asia and Howlers from South America to the Lemurs of Madagascar. All our primates live in a natural environment. At Monkeyland you are privileged to step into their world to explore and learn fascinating facts about primates first hand.

- **Activity 4: Birds of Eden**

The unique two hectare dome (the World's largest) spans over a gorge of indigenous forest. The sanctuary has its own mysterious ruin, which incorporates a walk-behind waterfall. Another feature is its amphitheater, which has the ability to seat over 200 visitors. The sanctuary's dome incorporates the ability to synthesise thunder and create short spells of rain from an irrigation system in the dome structure. Roofed viewpoints within the gorge have been erected for use during these brief rain storms. Birds of Eden boasts its own canopy walk, while shorter than the 128m bridge at Monkeyland, it hangs above the clouds. The decision to develop Birds of Eden stems from the need to create a safe environment in which to release a large collection of free-flight African birds, miniature monkeys and the sanctuary also enables bird owners to apply to release their pet birds into the sanctuary, after undergoing rehabilitation.

- **Activity 5: Natures Valley**

Nature's Valley is a small village situated at the mouth of the Groot River at the bottom of the Groot River pass alongside the Groot River estuary and forms part of the Tsitsikamma De Vasselot nature reserves.
