- **Day 1 & 2 & 3: George** *Distance from George to Knysna: 55.04km*

The sixth oldest town in South Africa, George lies at a junction along the Garden Route, where the main road continues along the coast and another heads north over the Outeniqua mountain to the Karoo town of Oudtshoorn.

Today, George is a modern Garden Route town with a sophisticated infrastructure. Banks, conference facilities, major shopping chains, transport and sporting facilities mean you have all comforts of a big city but plenty of small town charm with many historical landmarks.

Activities: Set slightly inland, George is close enough to both Victoria Bay and the Outeniqua Mountains to offer the outdoor-lover a range of activities, from surfing and swimming to hiking and cycling in the nearby mountains.

George is quickly developing into South Africa's golf paradise. Three of South Africa's top golf courses are found in George and golf-lovers flock here in droves. Particularly popular is the plush Fancourt Golf Estate with its 18-hole course designed by Gary Player.

A golf academy, an exclusive hotel, conference center, a couple of restaurants and a great number of sporting facilities are located in the huge park grounds.

Attractions: George has many historical landmarks to be visited, such as 'The Slave Tree', an ancient English oak planted by Landdrost van Kervel. The tree is a national monument and was given this name due to the very large chain and lock embedded in the trunk.

Continuing your journey along the Garden Route, your next destinations will be Wilderness, Sedge field, Knysna and the long sandy beaches of Plettenberg Bay.

• **Day 4 & 5 & 6: Knysna** *Distance from Knysna to Plettenberg Bay: 28.99km*

Knysna is the unofficial capital of the Garden Route, the official oyster capital of South Africa and a bustling little town (especially busy December and January) situated in the most spectacular natural surrounds.

With its lush forests (and elusive elephants), lakes, rivers and a tranquil lagoon, Knysna is the ideal destination for nature and outdoor-lovers. Its outdoor lifestyle is complemented by good restaurants, art galleries and lots of comfortable accommodation.

There's no shortage of restaurants on the Garden Route, and some really good ones at that.

Curio shops, restaurants and bars line the main road, and the nearby waterfront development contains a yacht harbour, restaurants and boutiques. Unsurprisingly, many people choose Knysna as the base for their Garden Route holiday.

Activities and Attractions: Knysna lazes by a warm, shallow lagoon that ebbs and flows with tides that gush through the narrow rocky entrance at the 'Heads', the enormous headlands that guard the entrance to the lagoon.

The road climbing to the top of the eastern Head yields superb views (especially towards sunset) and you can watch yachts surf through the narrow ocean channel to the safety of their moorings.

The other headland is known as the Featherbed Nature Reserve which features winding coastal and cliff walks through the pristine fynbos. Discover sandy coves, peer into giant caves and even stay for lunch.

Surrounding the lagoon is the indigenous Knysna forest, largest closed-canopy forest in Southern Africa featuring colossal Outeniqua Yellowwoods, stinkwoods, Hard Pear and other trees that are often hundreds of years old.

Mystery and History: The ancient indigenous forests used to be home to the Knysna elephants, the only forest-dwelling elephants in South Africa. Throughout history these elephants were hunted for their magnificent ivory and with their diminishing environment, it's uncertain whether any still survive in the depths of the forest.

The Knysna area is also famous for its most prominent, early 1800's resident Englishman, George Rex. The man with an obviously royal name arrived with such pomp and circumstance and lived in such style, that a rumor spread that he was the illegitimate son of King George III. Rec never confirmed nor denied this rumor, and the truth remains a mystery.

• **Day 7 & 8 & 9: Plettenberg Bay** *Distance from Plettenberg Bay to Mosselbay: 115.61km*

With plenty of sunshine, fantastic swimming beaches, numerous nature reserves and activities in the area, Plettenberg Bay (or Plett to most people), is an ideal base for exploring the Garden Route.

Originally christened Bahia Formosa (beautiful bay) by early Portuguese explorers, Plettenberg Bay's horseshoe-shaped bay is one of the most glamorous and beautiful spots along the Garden Route.

Plettenberg Bay consists of one busy main street with restaurants, cafes and enough shops to keep you busy.

Accommodation comes in every shape and size; on the beach in the form of the grand hotel, small and intimate guest houses scattered around the town or more discrete lodges in the indigenous forests that stretch along this fabulous coastline.

Plett's a party town: young and old coverage on her pretty shores in summer to enjoy nature's finest and to socialite when the sun eventually sets. At night, music and dancing are a great way to end an excellent meal in one of Plettenberg Bay's many restaurants or bars.

Attractions and Activities: If you want sand between your toes, Plettenberg Bay offers many beautiful beaches to choose from. Central Beach is just that, centrally located and fun for the whole family with views out to the ting of Tsitsikamma mountains in the distance. Robberg Beach is a sandy beach that may be centrally located at one end but stretches all the way to Robberg Peninsular in the distance.

Playful dolphins are regular visitors to these shores, there is a large permanent seal colony on Robberg Peninsula and between June and October whales are a very common sight. For an exhilarating experience take a boat out into the bay for up-close Marine Encounters.

Robberg Peninsula in the Robberg National Park has a winding path that takes you along rocky shores, [past seal colonies, through dunes and deserted beaches and is well worth the effort.

Plettenberg Bay is also perfectly positioned to experience other Garden Route activities. The bustling town of Knysna is not far away, neither are the tiny hamlets of Storms River & Nature's Valley.

The unique Canopy Tours, the Elephant Sanctuary, Birds of Eden and the Tsitsikamma National Park are all within easy driving distance of Plettenberg Bay.

• **Day 10 & 11: Mossel Bay** *Distance from Mossel Bay to George: 37.84km*

Mossel Bay is 392km from Cape town via the N2 coastal route and signals the start of the Garden Route. With 24km of white sandy beaches, including the only north-facing beach in South Africa, the protected bays of this seaside town are perfect for yachting, kayaking and boat trips to Seal Island.

Mossel Bay has it 'glitzy' side with the small and understated Garden Route Casino, but golf is where the real action is taking place and the region is fast becoming a golfer's destination.

The recently completed Pinnacle Point Golf Estate and Golf Resorts is the apple of the region's eye. It's a championship course with seven signature holes (most courses have on) perched on a cliff that stares out to sea. Part of the challenge is keeping your eye on the ball when the views are this good.
